# Who must register?

### What must be done?

There are three steps to complete:


- Adult registration with Mass Youth Soccer

# **Adult Registration**




2. Click on "Click on New Here? Create an Account"



# 3. Fill out the email and password information




4. Fill out your name and address information

5. Next you will see your member account page. Click on "Register Now"






7. Choose yourself and click "Add Registration for Selected Person"

### Registration for 2019/2020 Adult Registration Event




8. Check off "Coach Pool" and click on Continue to Registrant Information

- 9. There is a page where you fill in the remainder of your registration information. After filling in all information to the best of your ability, click "Continue to Photos"
- 10. If you have a photo to upload choose the file. If you don't have one now, you can upload the photo later. Click Continue to Waivers to move on.



11. There is a page with more information for you to fill out. Read through the information, fill them out and move through all of the waivers. One of the waivers asks for your social security number. Here is what the state told us about how they use the SS#:

We do require all adults to provide us with their full SS#. This is so we can have the proper and complete National Background Check, including a SS# trace performed for any person that comes back with a hit.

We use Reference Services Inc as our National Background Check provider. Here is a link to their web site and information about data security with them: http://www.referenceservices.com/consumer-info/

Below is the link to Stack documentation on privacy. Stack does not want the SSN data but we collect it so CORI and RSI can work. Stack Sports does not maintain the SSN after it has been provided to RSI. Without it, the registrant cannot be processed through either.


### How secure is the Stack Sports Connect system and software?

Stack Sports Connect software platform is fully (<u>PCI DSS</u>) compliant which is the Payment Card Industry Data Security Standard that governs and ensures that ALL companies that accept, process, store or transmit credit card information maintain a secure environment. We also maintain operational procedures for <u>COPPA</u> compliance which is the Children's Online Privacy Protection Rule directive for collecting personal information online from a child under the age of 13. We furthermore have integrated document encryption, <u>User Permissions</u> access control and all Club's and Leagues also own their own personnel data within the Connect platform.

- 15. In your account, you see the registration and a checklist of items you need to complete




- 16. There are 4 radio buttons:







# Safe Sport Certification

Every coach must complete the safe sport certification each year. The first year the course takes approximately one to two hours. The recertification for subsequent years should be shorter (approximately 25 minutes).

1. Click on Begin Training on the abuse preventions certificate item.




2. Copy the access code and then click Begin Safesport Training:


# This SafeSport training course covers Sexual Misconduct Awareness Education is geared toward coaches, team volunteers, officials or team staff members (athletic trainer, team doctor, etc.). You are eligible to take this training through your sport's National Governing Body, U.S. Soccer and became a requirement due to federal legislation passed in 2018. Copy U.S. Soccer Access Code below. Your U.S. Soccer Access Code is required to access your training. Access Code YC3E-6P5G-YYIL-CS2M © Your training course is not timed and can take around 1-2 hours to complete. Your first name, last name, and date of birth must match the information input in Safe Sport to validate and approve completed courses.

3. If you have already completed safesport training, they will have emailed you a certificate which you can upload using the "Upload Safesport certificate" button

4. When you create an account, select US Soccer and enter the access code you copied



5. Create a Safe Sport account:



- 6. Be sure to use the e-mail in Safe Sport that you used for your adult registration. The systems should integrate based on that e-mail.
- 7. Complete the course.
